Exposure can also affect color vision and hearing Symptoms may get worse as toluene levels in the air or skin contact increases Over time, exposure to high concentrations, day after day, may lead to tiredness and slow reaction, difficulty sleeping, numbness in the hands or feet, or female reproductive system damage and pregnancy loss

4.1 OCCUPATIONAL EXPOSURE ASSESSMENT

Occupational Exposure Limit (OEL) is an allowable concentration or intensity of a hazardous agent in the employee’s immediate work environment over a given period of time OELs are generally expressed as 8-hour time weighted averages (TWA) or as

exposure prophylaxis (PEP) is indicated, efficacy is time sensitive The first dose should be given as soon as possible Optimal time to start PEP is within hours of exposure, rather than days1 Will I need follow-up testing? This direction will come from the health care provider Follow-up will depend upon the testing outcome of the source person

Monkey Bite Exposure Treatment Protocol

Department at WRAMC for laboratory exposure to herpes B emphasizes copious flooding of the wound site for at least 15 minutes with water while scrubbing with povidone iodine or other antimicrobial solution This procedure should be emphasized for all bites/scratches or mechanical wounds potentially contaminated with monkey body fluids
