blood sugars Then you can do something about it Blood sugar can be high if you: 5 If you have high blood sugar often or at certain times of the day, tell your doctor or diabetes educator You should also tell them if and when you have symptoms (signs) of high blood sugar, such as: feeling tired

Blood Clots in the Legs About 1-2% of patients will get a blood clot during the first 4-6 weeks You must watch for symptoms A blood clot in your leg can cause pain or swelling in your calf, ankle or leg If a clot breaks loose, it can travel to the lung and cause a pulmonary embolus, which could lead to death Symptoms are chest
