Poetic Devices A) Figurative Language Stanza - Two or more lines of poetry that together form one of the divisions of a poem The stanzas of a poem are usually the same length and follow the same pattern of meter and rhyme Refrain - A line or lines repeated at intervals during a poem, usually at the end of each stanza A refrain
